1.0 The Braithwaite Burn And Jessop Construction Company Limited (BBJ), a premier Public Sector Enterprise of Govt. of India engaged in construction of major Civil and Structural Engineering work invites Expression of Interest (EOI) applications from reputed and established Civil and Structural Engineering Indian firms/ contractors to constitute Joint Venture for participation in the following tenders, invited by Ircon International Limited vide Tender Notice No.: IRCON/CO/KGS/Civil/UP/107 where JV Partner shall be the Lead Member;

2.0 Construction of Up Line Railway Grade separator running over New Katni Junction & Katni Murwara yards and comprising construction of Rail Viaducts on Pile foundation, composite steel girders and Deck Slabs, Open Web Girders, Retaining Walls, minor bridges, Earthwork & allied other civil engineering works in Katni District, Madhya Pradesh for Katni grade Separator project of West Central Railway (Package-2)

2.0 Scope of Work

For detailed scope of work please refer. IRCON's original tender document. The division of scope of work between the members may be mutually discussed before bid submission.

3.0 Interested firms/ contractor shall have to submit necessary documents in support of complying the following eligibility criteria along with their application of Expression of Interest for aforesaid work.

a) Eligibility Criteria:

1. Experience in similar nature of work (Technical Capacity);

As proof of possessing the Experience in similar nature of work for carrying out the proposed work, bidder should possess the experience of having successfully completed / substantially completed similar works during the last 7 years (ending last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited), which should be any one of the following :-

- (i) One similar work costing not less than the amount equal to 60% of the advertised Cost of the work, or
- (ii) Two similar works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the advertised Cost of the work, or
- (iii) Three similar works costing not less than the amount equal to 30% of the advertised Cost of the work.

Notes –

- i) "Similar work" for this contract shall be "Construction of Bridge/Flyover/Viaduct in Railway/Metro/Highway/Expressway projects"
- ii) The work should include Construction of Bridge/Flyover/Viaduct. In case of composite work, value of any other major component such as Approaches with RE wall/Retaining wall, Roads, Buildings etc. shall not be considered. Value of the component such as Bridge/ Flyover/ Viaduct in Railway/Metro/Highway/ Expressway projects should be separately mentioned in Performance certificates.
- iii) The contractor should submit performance certificates and Letter of Award in reference to Serial Number 1 (Minimum 3 nos., 2 nos. or 1 no. as the case may be) above issued by Government Organizations/ Semi Government Organizations/ Public Sector Undertakings/ Autonomous bodies/ Municipal bodies/ Public Limited Company / Concessionaire Company/ Private Company/ JV Company for having successfully completed similar works in the last 7 years. Certificates issued by such Public Limited Company / Concessionaire Company/ Private Company/ JV Company must be supported by Tax Deducted at Source (TDS) Certificates (Form 16A/ 26AS) in evidence of the value of work executed.
- iv) All documents related to certification of completion of the "similar work" issued by above shall be submitted, duly Notarized by a Notary Officer.
- v) The value of similar work done shall be updated as per the Value Enhancement Factor (VEF) given below:

* The VEF shall be applied for the respective year in which work under consideration has been completed.

- vi) Substantial completion means the value of the executed work should be 90 (Ninety) per cent or more of the OCV or RCV subject to the contract has not been terminated.
- vii) If the bidder is a JV, then the JV and its constituent members should fulfill the above requirement as below:

 As proof of possessing the technical capability for carrying out the proposed work, bidder should have executed quantity shown against each activities below:

Notes -

- The minimum quantity mentioned in above table may be covered under one contract or more than one contracts.
- The quantity may be from completed/ongoing works.
- These items of work should have been executed during the previous 7 financial years, i.e. 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18, and 2018 - 2019 and up to the submission of the bid in the current FY. Proof of executed item of work shall be sought from employer and shall

be certified by employer.

- d) In case of JV, the arithmetic sum of quantities executed by all the members shall be taken as quantities executed by JV to satisfy this requirement.

2. Bid Capacity;

Available Bid Capacity should be more than the Estimated / advertised cost of work. The available bid capacity shall be derived as below;

Available Bid Capacity = $2 \times A \times N - B$ Where,

A = Maximum value of works executed in any one year during the last 5 years which will take into account the completed work as well as works in progress (total contract receipts)

B = Total value of existing commitments during the completion period of this tender w.e.f the first day of the month of tender submission. In case bidder has existing commitment through another JV, then the commitment will be taken in proportion to the share of the bidder in the JV.

N = Number of years prescribed for completion of works in the present tender.

Notes:

- a) The Tenderer(s) shall furnish the details of existing commitments and balance amount of ongoing works with tenderer as per the prescribed proforma (Format -5) for statement of all works in progress and also the works which are awarded to tenderer but yet not started upto the date of opening of tender. In case of no works in hand, a 'NIL' statement should be furnished. This statement should be submitted duly verified by Statutory Auditor of the Bidder. Further such certificate should have UDIN.
- b) Value of a completed work/works in progress/work awarded but yet not started for a Member in an earlier JV shall be reckoned only to the extent of the concerned member's share in that JV for the purpose of satisfying his/her compliance to the above mentioned technical eligibility criteria in the tender under consideration.
- c) In case, the tenderer/s failed to submit the above statement along with offer, their/his offer shall be considered as incomplete and is liable to be rejected.
- d) The available bid capacity of tenderer shall be assessed based on the details submitted by the tenderer. In case, the available Bid Capacity is lesser than estimate cost of work put to tender, his offer shall not be considered even if he has been found eligible in other eligibility criteria/tender requirement.

3. Net Worth;

The contractor should have Net worth of atleast 10% of the Estimated/ advertised cost of the work. This will be judged from the Audited Balance Sheet of the last financial year ending on a date not prior to 18 months from the date of submission of the tender. In case of JV, the arithmetic sum of individual "Net worth" of all the members shall be taken as JV's "Net Worth" to satisfy this requirement.

4. Annual turnover;

As a proof of possessing the financial capability of executing the proposed work, the cumulative annual turnover during last three (03) years should be at least 150% of Estimated / advertised cost.

Notes:

- a) The financial turnover shall be judged from ITCC or Annual Reports including Profit and Loss Account.
- b) If the Annual Reports including Profit and Loss Account for the Financial Year of 2018-19 has not been audited, Annual Reports including Profit and Loss Account for the F.Y. '2017-18, 2016-17 & 2015-16 shall be considered and same should be submitted.
- c) If the Annual Reports including Profit and Loss Account for the Financial Year of 2018-19 has been audited, Annual Reports including Profit and Loss Account for the F.Y. '2018-19, 2017-18 & 2016-17 shall be considered and same should be submitted.

5. Submission of Affidavit;

The bidder shall sign and submit the Affidavit as enclosed in Annexure-IV of "Instruction to Tenderer" of the original bid document.

Authentic Certificates shall be produced by the tenderer(s) to this effect which may be an attested Certificate from the employer/ client, Audited Balance Sheet duly certified by the Chartered Accountant etc.

Note: Certificate from private individuals/ firms for whom such works are executed / being executed shall not be considered.

- (a)
 - (i) The Firm shall furnish General Details of their Organization in attached **Format- I**
 - (ii) The firm shall furnish list of completed work in last 3 (three) financial years and current financial year in attached **Format-II** along with Completion Certificates.
 - (ii) The firm shall furnish list of ongoing projects in hand in **Format-III**
 - (iii) The firm shall furnish list of Plant & Equipment in attached **Format-IV** showing their present Site of deployment in remarks column. Planning for deployment of Plant & Machinery is to be indicated separately if JV is formed for the above tenders.
 - (b) The firm/contractor must have sound financial standing and must submit documentary evidence of sound financial standing from any bank along with Bank Account number. The firm/contractor has to authorize BBJ to seek reference in this regard from the banker issuing the documentary evidence.
 - (c) The firm/contractor must submit a list of key personnel employed along with their bio-data in the attached **Format-V** along with the application.

- (d) The firm/contractor must submit information regarding involvement in any litigation, current or during last 5 (five) years along with name(s) of parties concerned and other details of the dispute in attached **Format VI**.
- (e) The firm/contractor must submit PAN and PF code number issued by appropriate Govt. Authority.
- (f) The firm/contractor must submit GST registration number issued by appropriate Govt. Authority.
- (g) The firm/contractor must be an Indian Registered Firm.
- (h) The firm shall comply with all the guidelines for formation of JV as stipulated in the original bid document. Also the Firm shall bear all expenditure, share the Earnest Money amount, cost of tender document etc. at pre-tender stage in proportion to his share of participation for submission of tender and prepare all documents as would be necessary to be done by JV Member. If the JV wins the contract then each JV member shall bear expenditure towards Performance Guarantee and any other BG, sales tax registration and other similar expenditure in proportion to their respective contract price. All incidental expenses shall be borne by Lead member and not by BBJ, the JV Member. The selected Lead member will provide declaration in Rs.100/- (Rupees one hundred only) Stamp Paper duly Notarized that they/he will not bid singly or in JV with other firm for the same tender.
- (i) Other documents as per original bid document of IRCON.
