

13. **SPLITTING OF SCOPE OF WORK**

BBJ reserves the absolute right to split the scope of work in terms of number (span-wise) and/or quantity (MT) among the techno-commercially qualified bidders, based on BBJ's requirements and at its sole discretion. In such cases, the L-2 bidder shall be required to match the final accepted rates and other terms and conditions of the L-1 bidder.

No bidder shall have any claim arising out of any reduction in quantity from their scope of supply due to such splitting. The allocation of work, if split, will be done only at the negotiated lowest accepted rate.

The order quantity will be reviewed periodically by BBJ and based on the progress of production and project requirements; the quantities may be revised or reduced as deemed necessary.

BBJ's decision in this regard shall be final and binding on all bidders, and no claims shall be entertained on this account.

22. 

SCOPE OF WORKS

1. BRIEF SCOPE OF WORK OF THE AGENCY:

The scope of work will include but not limited to the following and the quoted rate should take in to consideration the following:

The scope of work shall comprehensively cover fabrication, trial assembly, surface preparation, metalizing, painting, inspection, documentation and transportation of Open Web Steel Girders for Bridge No. 391 (15 × 61.0 m) and Bridge No. 50 (14 × 61.0 m), strictly in accordance with Railway specifications, approved drawings and quality standards of (RDSO).

1.1 PRE-FABRICATION ACTIVITIES

- (a) Study the drawings, structural details, material lists and technical specifications issued by BBJ / RDSO / Railway.
- (b) Preparation of the following documents and obtaining approval from Railway/RDSO/authorized agencies prior to commencement of fabrication:
 - Quality Assurance Plan (QAP)
 - Welding Procedure Specification (WPS)
 - Welding Procedure Qualification Record (WPQR)
 - Welder Qualification Test (WQT) records
 - Stage inspection formats and checklists
- (c) Establishment of designated fabrication bays within the RDSO-approved workshop, including separate areas for:
 - Raw material stacking (minimum 150 mm above ground level)
 - Fabrication and assembly
 - Welding and NDT
 - Trial assembly
 - Surface preparation and metalizing
 - Finished material stacking and dispatch

1.2 MATERIAL HANDLING AND TESTING

- (a) Receipt, unloading and proper stacking of structural steel / section (supplied free of cost by BBJ).
- (b) Verification of material test certificates (MTCs) and identification marking.
- (c) Conducting confirmatory tests of raw materials (except steel supplied by BBJ), if required under QAP, through NABL-approved laboratories.
- (d) Safe custody and accounting of steel supplied by BBJ, including reconciliation and submission of consumption statements.

1.3 FABRICATION WORKS

- (a) Marking, cutting, drilling, edge preparation and machining as per approved drawings.
- (b) Preparation of templates, jigs, fixtures, bushes and layouts required for accurate fabrication.
- (c) Assembly and fit-up of members ensuring dimensional tolerances as per IRS/RDSO specifications.
- (d) Complete welding of all components as per approved WPS/WPQR, including:
 - Fillet welds
 - Splice welds
 - Stiffeners, gussets, diaphragms and bracings
- (e) Straightening of members wherever required to meet geometric tolerances.

- (f) Supply and installation of service bolts, drifts and temporary fasteners required for trial assembly.

- (b) Dimensional inspection of fabricated components.



SPECIAL CONDITION OF CONTRACT

1. **DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION**

In this Tender Document, as hereinafter defined, the following words and expressions shall have the meaning as under:

- a) "**BBJ**" shall mean The Braithwaite Burn And Jessop Construction Company Limited having its registered office at 27, R. N. Mukherjee Road, Kolkata-700 001.
- b) "**TENDER**" shall mean the proposal submitted by the Tenderer/ Bidder/ Supplier/ Dealer/ Bidder in response to BBJ's Notice of Invitation to this Tender Document.
- c) "**ORDER**" shall mean a written Work/ Purchase Order issued by BBJ.
- d) "**TENDERER/ BIDDER**" shall mean the firm or Company (hereinafter called Tenderer/ Bidder) who duly submits the tender after accepting all the terms & conditions of the tender document.
- e) "**SUCCESSFUL BIDDER**" whose tender has been finally accepted by BBJ.

2. **COMPLETION PERIOD**

Time is the essence of this contract. The duration of work is **nine (09) months**, and the date of commencement will be considered the date of issue of a Letter of Intent (LOI)/ Letter of Acceptance (LOA)/ Work Order, whichever is earlier.

This completion period includes the Monsoon Period.

If the overall completion schedule needs to be extended due to any reason which is solely beyond the control of the successful bidder, the said extension of the completion schedule shall be granted without L.D.

3. **EXTENSION OF COMPLETION PERIOD:**

If there is a delay for reasons not attributable to the successful bidder, BBJ, upon receipt of a written request from the successful bidder may extend the Milestone/ Completion time as suitable and fit reasonable to BBJ. No extra claim (including escalation) from the bidder will be entertained in such cases of time extension is granted.

4. **WORKMANSHIP:**

The workmanship for the job shall be closely monitored by the Bidder's supervisory staff as per the specification and as directed by the Engineer/ Engineer In-Charge of BBJ/Railway and/or any other authorized Bidder of Railway. Any work done by the successful bidder is found unsatisfactory or a major mismatch is observed at the site that should be rectified/ redone as per the instructions, immediately after notifying the successful bidder. 8.3 Mandatory Trial Assembly Requirement

The Successful Bidder shall carry out trial assembly of each girder span or as directed by the Engineer-in-Charge to ensure dimensional accuracy, camber, alignment, and fit-up of all members. No girder shall be permitted for dispatch without successful completion of trial assembly and inspection clearance by the Employer/Inspecting Authority.

8.4 Monitoring and Progress Review

- a) The Successful Bidder shall submit a detailed monthly progress report indicating milestone-wise progress.
- b) The Employer or its authorized representative shall review and monitor progress periodically.

priority specified by the Employer. Fabrication of all girders without dispatch as per milestone schedule shall not be considered as satisfactory progress.

8.7 **Slow Progress**

If the Successful Bidder fails to achieve minimum 50% fabrication within 180 days or fails to complete the work within the stipulated milestones indicating inability to complete the work within Contract Period, the Employer shall have the right to terminate the Contract.

9. **TERMS OF PAYMENT:**

9.1 **40% (forty per cent)** of the accepted rate will be released within 30 days after fabrication of bridge components in black condition, span-wise complete in all respect as per approved drawing/material list duly inspected by BBJ / RAILWAY and RDSO and/or their authorised agency but before receipt of I.C. from RAILWAY/ RDSO and/or their authorized agency.

10. **TAXES & DUTIES**

The successful bidder shall be exclusively responsible for payment of all Taxes, Royalties etc. (**including Goods and Service Tax**) that may be levied from time to time according to the Laws & regulations now in force & also hereafter to be imposed, increased or modified from time to time. Nothing will be payable extra by the Company in respect of any duties/ taxes to be imposed on the procurement of materials for execution of the contract.

- the successful bidder fails to provide the invoice/debit/credit notes in the form and manner prescribed under GST, then in the event of such non-compliance of the GST Act/Rules, the successful bidder shall be liable to indemnify for any losses to the Company.
- 11.3 The successful bidder shall raise their tax invoice in the regular interval as per contract condition and upload their supply invoice in GSTN Portal through GSTR-1 return with 10th of next month. Mismatch in return of BBJ due to any reason attributable to the bidder, the same shall be recovered from Bidder's bill.

12. **NEW LEVIES/ TAXES**

In case Government imposes any new levy/tax or modifies rate of existing taxes including GST after awarding of the work during the tenure of the contract, BBJ shall reimburse the same at actual on submission of documentary proof of payment subject to the satisfaction of BBJ that such new levy/tax applies to this contract.

13. **METHOD OF MEASUREMENT FOR PAYMENT**

Measurement of girder components will be done as per the material statement. The material statement will be prepared as per the actual shape and size of plates used in the girder components on the theoretical weight of the steel i.e. 7850 Kg/Cum. Weight of Sections, Structural Angles, Channels, Pipes etc. will be taken as per relevant IS code. No additional weight for weld etc. will be taken into account. The above weight will also be used for material reconciliation.

14. **FREE ISSUE AND RECONCILIATION OF RAW STEEL**

Raw steel if supplied by BBJ will be **against Bank Guarantee/ Indemnity Bond and Insurance Policy for the requisite value of steel** to run the work smoothly as the fabrication work will be carried out at the successful bidder/fabricator's premises.

Safekeeping of raw steel materials will be the successful bidder's responsibility. The steel and other free issue material supplied by BBJ will be used in the BBJ job only. Under no circumstances, the material supplied by BBJ shall be used in works other than BBJ. If it is found, then the value of the material with 2 times that value as penal charges shall be recovered from the successful bidder.

- a) **Wastage: 0.5% (half percent)** of material list weight shall be allowed as wastage of steel in the process of fabrication work. The cutting plan of the materials will be issued by BBJ and to be followed accordingly.

In such event of extension, a penal interest of 12% (twelve percent) per annum on Performance Guarantee value shall be charged for the delay beyond 21 (twenty-one) days, i.e., from 22nd day after the date of issue of LOA and up to the actual date of submission. In case the successful bidder fails to submit the Performance Guarantee even within the extended period, as aforesaid, the bid of the successful bidder shall be liable for rejection by the BBJ administration, and the LOA shall stand withdrawn.

- completion of work plus 60 days.
- d) In case the successful bidder fails to submit the requisite Performance Guarantee within the stipulated period as mentioned in the above paragraphs, the bid may consequentially be cancelled by BBJ, and the LOA shall stand withdrawn. The defaulting successful bidder shall be debarred from participating in Re-Tender for that work and his EMD/ SD/ PG/RA Bills shall be encashed/ invoked/ forfeited. In this regard, the decision of the Competent Authority of BBJ shall be final.
- e) The formal Order shall be issued/ contract agreement (if any) shall be executed within a reasonable time only after receipt of Performance Guarantee from successful bidder. 17. **QUANTITY VARIATION**

- 17.1 There may be quantity variation as approved by BBJ/Railway during the actual execution of work.

26. **SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENT AT SITE/SHOP**

- 26.1 The successful bidder shall strictly abide by all safety standards, specifications, practices, rules, and regulations in construction and also the instruction of our safety (EHS) Engineer. Any kind of unsafe action or unsafe method of work by The Successful bidder's workmen, which may lead to injury to the successful bidder's workmen, will be viewed seriously and a penalty for the same will be levied on the successful bidder for such unsafe actions.

- 26.6 The successful bidder's authorized representative shall attend all safety meetings convened by the site safety (EHS) Engineer and abide by his instructions and follow the site safety practices without failure.

29. **TERMINATION OF CONTRACT**

In the event, BBJ finds that the successful Bidder's progress is consistently below the accepted pace based on the program scheduled mentioned in this document or fixed by BBJ and/or if the quality of works being executed by the successful Bidder falls below the expected standards laid down by BBJ, in such cases, in the interest of timely and successful completion of the project and to maintain the high quality of work, BBJ reserve the right to delete the Scope of Work of the successful Bidder, or, the entire balance work to be taken away from the successful Bidder and BBJ shall be at liberty to get such works done/executed by any other Bidder/ agencies. Moreover, BBJ shall not be liable to pay any compensation or make good any damage/s or to affect any other payment to the present successful bidder for any ground whatsoever.

In the above event, the successful bidder shall be debarred from participating in the tender for executing the balance work. If the successful bidder is a JV or a Partnership firm, then every member/partner of such a firm shall be debarred from participating in the tender for the balance work in his/her individual capacity or as a partner of any other JV /partnership firm.

The defaulting successful bidder shall not be issued any completion certificate for the contract.

30. **RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES AND ARBITRATION**

In case a dispute or difference of any kind whatsoever arises out of or relates to the Contract or ancillary/incidental as to the terms and conditions of it or relates to any matter for execution and/or performance of the contract, between the parties to the Contract, it is a term of the agreement by and between the parties herein that before invoking arbitration, the aggrieved party shall first & foremost refer the matter within sixty (60) days from the date of cause of action of the said dispute(s) or difference(s) arosed, to the Competent Authority of BBJ and the

decision/recommendation/interpretation made by the said Competent Authority of BBJ shall be final & binding upon both the parties.

On the failure of the procedure prescribed above or if a party is dissatisfied with the decisions/recommendations aforesaid, and notwithstanding anything else contained elsewhere, the aggrieved party may by notice in writing to the Competent Authority of BBJ evince the intention to refer the disputes and differences that have arisen between the parties to Arbitration by the constitution of an Arbitral Tribunal. The Arbitral Tribunal shall consist of three arbitrators, one each to be nominated by the respective parties and the third to be appointed by the nominated arbitrators.

Pending submission of and/or decision on a dispute or difference as aforesaid or until the Arbitral Award is published, the parties (if the Contract is not terminated/ cancelled) shall continue to perform all of their obligations under this Agreement and the Contract, without prejudice to a final adjustment in accordance with such award.

The decision of the Arbitral Tribunal arrived at after hearing the parties shall be final and binding upon the parties. The Arbitration Proceedings shall be conducted in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modifications or re-enactments thereof.

It is also agreed by the parties that the Arbitration Proceedings shall be conducted in the English language. The venue of Arbitration shall be Kolkata only and any proceedings arising out of this Agreement / Contract shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Courts at Kolkata.

While executing the work by the Bidder and/or after completion of the work and/ or till completion of the maintenance period as per order, a dispute or difference of any kind whatsoever arises out of or relates due to actions of the Railway and/ or the Bidder, the same will at first instance be settled amicably with the Railway through BBJ. In case amicable settlement cannot be reached and it is required to initiate arbitration proceeding by BBJ with the Railway, the Bidder will bear entire costs related to arbitration proceedings including legal expenses, incidental costs e.g. costs related to travelling, food & lodging of BBJ's representatives including BBJ's legal experts/ lawyers, costs of documentation etc.

31. **FORCE MAJEURE:**

If any time, during the continuance of this contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party under obligation as per this contract is prevented or delayed by reasons of any war or hostility, the act of the public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fire, flood, explosion, epidemic, quarantine restrictions, strike, lockout or acts of God (hereinafter referred to as "eventuality"), provided notice of happening of any such eventuality is given by either party to the other within 21 (Twenty) days of the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall because of such an "eventuality" be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim or damages against the other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance and deliveries under the contract. The contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such "eventuality" has come to an end or ceased to exist.

In case of any dispute, the decision of BBJ shall be final and conclusive, provided further that if the performance in whole or part of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed because of any such eventuality for a period exceeding 60 (Sixty) days, either party may at its options, terminate the contract.

Provided that if the contract is terminated under this clause, the Purchaser shall be at liberty to take over from the supplier at a price to be fixed by the purchaser, which shall be final, all unused, undamaged and acceptable equipment, bought out components and other stores in the course of manufacture which may be in the possession of the Supplier at the time of such termination, or such portion thereof as BBJ may deem fit except such equipment, as the Supplier may, with the concurrence of the Purchaser, elect to retain.
